DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
40-HOUR TRAINING

The Domestic Violence 40-Hour Training is the basic training for new domestic violence workers. The training comes from the grassroots domestic violence movement's perspective, providing participants with the movement's philosophical and political framework. Interactive education models and skill building activities are used to convey ideas.

WHY 40 HOURS?

Under the Illinois state law — the Illinois Domestic Violence Act (IDVA) — staff and volunteers of domestic violence programs are **required** to complete a 40-Hour training to maintain confidentiality for their work with women, children and men experiencing domestic violence.

WHAT ABOUT CERTIFICATION?

Completion of **all** 40 Hours of this training course will earn each participant a certificate stating that they have completed a 40-Hour training. This is a necessary step towards becoming an Illinois Certified Domestic Violence Professional (ICDVP) through the ICDVP Board of Directors. **To request an ICDVP test application packet call Continental Testing Services at: (708) 354-9911.**

The CTI is an ICDVP approved training site.
